



# 2019 ROSÉ OF GRENACHE

Spear Vineyards | Sta. Rita Hills AVA | 13% ABV

**VINEYARD:** Spear Vineyards  
**HARVEST DATE:** 9/23/2019 (3.04pH / 22.5 Brix at harvest)  
**VINIFICATION:** Whole cluster direct press to stainless tank for fermentation. No Malolactic Conversion.  
**ELEVAGE:** 6 months neutral French oak  
**BLEND:** 100% Grenache

“ Picked specifically for Rosé, this Grenache from Sta. Rita Hills Spear Vineyards was whole cluster pressed and fermented in stainless steel. Then transferred to neutral oak barrels and aged for 6 months. We did not block Malolactic Conversion but it did not finish it due to the extremely low PH. The sharp acidity was rounded out by the use of barrel giving it a fleshy feel. As with the 2018 the nose is mellow and not intrusive. Classic Rosé flavors of lemon peel and orange rinds with the salinity only SRH can deliver.”
